
Brothers and sisters in Christ,



Meeting called to order at 6:00 p.m. Present: Pastor Isaiah, Tanner Nelson, Tom Axness, Steve Strandlien, Donna Dunham, Becky Lage, Bonnie Harry, Robbie Shulstad, Brenda Haugrud, Nolan Dunham, Grant Meyer and Julie Ann Holt.

Pastor opened the meeting with devotions and prayer.

Pastor's report: Pastor reported that he keeps track of visitation, and makes sure to get to each person once per month. He is currently attending a CPE (Clinical Pastoral Education) class on Tuesdays and is finding these teachings relevant in many aspects of being a church pastor as well. He will be on vacation 6/18-6/24. He will be gone 7/14-7/20 for army training in Seattle, and he will be gone 8/11-8/25.

Secretary's report: Donna noted that a correction be made: Shelly Dunham also was involved in putting the finishing touches on the Ruby Linder scholarship guidelines.

Treasurer's report: Julie Ann reviewed the budget and provided rates to aid in decisions regarding the 2 CDs that became due on June 9. Steve made a motion to combine the two CDs into one 12-month CD at Minnesota National Bank, Nolan seconded the motion, motion carried. Council was also informed that 2 more CDs will become due on July 9. Julie Ann announced that she is retiring as North Immanuel church treasurer, with an end date of September 2024.

Committee reports:

Evangelism Committee: MN Teen challenge (with the choir and testimonies) will be coming to North Immanuel October 27, 2024. Since they are coming from Alexandria they asked if the service time could be moved to 10:00 a.m. A potluck will follow this service. Any ideas on advertising for the event are welcome. The funeral pall was ordered, should be here in August. Tom (and Conni), Becky (and Mike) and Nolan volunteered to help Bryant and Allie serve lunch following the June 23rd outdoor service. Pastor Roger Michaelson will cover pulpit supply August 18.

Confirmation students want better communication regarding confirmation class, learning/expectations going forward. Donna reported that the council's responsibility regarding the Ruby Linder scholarship lies only in making sure funds are available for said scholarship.
