Meeting called to order at 6:00 p.m. Present: Pastor Isaiah, Tanner Nelson, Tom Axness, Steve Strandlien, Donna Dunham, Becky Lage, Bonnie Harry, Robbie Shulstad, Brenda Haugrud and Julie Ann Holt. Absent: Nolan Dunham and Grant Meyer.

Pastor opened the meeting with devotions and prayer.

Pastor's report: Pastor and two others from North Immanuel attended the Teen Challenge Gala and will be reaching out to the program manager to see if they will visit our church. Pastor mentioned that Allie and Bryant are interested in teaching 6th-7th graders in the fall after church services at least once per month. Confirmation will start in the fall as well. Senior recognition will be May 12. On May 27, Pastor will be assisting with the Memorial Day service in Pelican Rapids. He will be on vacation 6/18-6/24. He will be gone 7/14-7/20 for army training in Seattle, but this won't affect pulpit supply. He reminded us that he will be at Camp Ripley 8/11-8/25.

Secretary's report: read, accepted and placed on file.

Treasurer's report: Julie Ann reviewed the budget and stated that 2 CDs are coming due on June 9. She will provide the interest rates at the next meeting to help council make decisions on what to do with these funds. She noted that the Godchild Program went up \$60 per child, and that is why the budgeted amount was exceeded in that category.

Council will serve on whichever outdoor service there is a need. Pastor requested a funeral pall and explained it's significance, a motion was passed to make the purchase, Bonnie will order.

Christian Education: Donna (and Connie) put the finishing touches on the Ruby Linder scholarship guidelines and will bring copies to the council. Robbie ordered the cake for senior recognition day.
