To all the saints at North Immanuel Lutheran Church:


I begin by thanking you for allowing me to be part of your worshipping community and to partner with you in doing the work of the church.



Pastor's report: NA

Secretary's report: Read and placed on file.

Treasurer's report: The budget was reviewed and placed on file. In preparation of Julie Ann's retirement as treasurer, she will be removed as a NI check-signer from Minnesota National Bank and Bell Bank in Pelican Rapids and from Midwest Bank in Barnesville. NI's new treasurer, Shyla Strandlien, will be added to those banks as a signer. Jane Knorr and Dar Hovland will remain as signers for both Pelican Rapids banks, and Shelly Dunham will remain a signer at the Barnesville bank.
